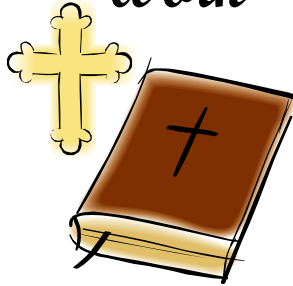


# *Middle School Memory Work*

### MEMORY WORK

Each verse is used for two weeks. The first week students are responsible for writing the verse (including the scripture reference) and in the second week students are responsible for writing the verse **and** the meaning.

August 27<sup>th</sup> - Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant,  
Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup> and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

Mark 10:43b-45

Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> – Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love  
Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> as brothers, be compassionate and humble. Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.
